

The Discourse of Hope Seminar

Seminar Overview

In the aftermath of recent crises, especially since October 7th, children and youth have faced fear and uncertainty. This 2–3 day seminar creates a space for dialogue, learning, and workshops focused on hope, resilience, and leadership in times of crisis.

Participants engage with Israeli society through meetings with youth movement counselors, social activists, and shared society initiatives, gaining insight into the resilience of Israeli society and the Jewish people after October 7th.

Program Highlights

- Facilitated dialogue and experiential workshops
- Site visits, mifgashim, and inspiring encounters
- Leadership tools for fostering hope in communities
- Poems of Hope, Songs of Hope, pins of hope and other practical tools.

Led by an experienced Mechanech/et from the Machon, the seminar equips participants with tools to lead hope-based workshops at home.

Additional Components

- Exposure to Shnat Hashara and future opportunities at the Machon.
- Possible affordable, quality accommodation available in Kiryat Moria for two nights.
