Seminar Overview

This 2–3 day seminar explores personal leadership styles through encounters with Israeli leadership models, past and present. Participants connect leadership theory with real-life practice through learning, field experiences, and meaningful meetings across Israeli society.

- Which leadership models inspire me?
- How do personal and group leadership connect?
- How can Israeli leadership empower my community work?

Educational Leadership

Tools for youth movements and camps, informal education, and discussing Israel.

Campus Preparation

Antisemitism, anti-Israel sentiment, Jewish campus life, and social media strategies

Israel–World Jewry Relations

Strengthening ties between Israel and Jewish communities worldwide
